What I did for this Capstone was make a podcast on Batman, one that is the longest I've ever made and is a first for me especially because the length was a whopping 4hrs. Don't get me wrong, it was really fun and I've never done anything like it. I did the podcast by myself and edited the whole thing on my own.

This was a personal project, something I've been wanting to do for a long time, and reflects my childhood experiences with who I believe is the greatest superhero to ever be created. Being the first of many personal projects to come for me, this is the beginning of something even greater as I move on into the upcoming summer and the rest of my life. I knew that doing this project on Batman was the right thing to do from the start but I wasn't sure if that was ok at first when I got the green light I started right away.

My capstone represents the SLA values because the first value Inquiry asking for information I asked about what I could do for a capstone and if it was ok to do a project on Batman I also talked to one of my dad's friends about Batman and his experience with the character which was about 2hrs. During this process of asking for information, I gathered different experiences and had my questions answered. Now onto research' The amount of research I did at the beginning was insane. I put the effort into getting an early start but then kinda forgot because of projects and constant work but I pursued my passion of getting this thing done. Focusing on the fundamentals of the character Batman' who he is and who he was. This was truly a journey one that I will never forget even if this tends to be something I just did for fun and want more knowledge of Batman.

I took a lot of steps to complete this capstone most notably keeping myself engaged in the material during this 3-month process of working on my capstone. I knew this was going to be hard regardless of what path I took. I kept myself working on my capstone even when I had to push it aside for other work. I would most likely prioritize research more than people's opinions about the character or my ideals but just the facts.

After all, I was a student here because I made a lot of friends/connections that I hope to keep for the rest of my life' these connections I feel like had an impact on SLA and myself as a student because I seem to have become known as the person who always gets there work done regardless of why, when or how I just get it done and I feel like that mentality kind of leaked throughout my friendships and represented a moto. My time here has been nothing short of crazy so much has happened in these 4 years than the entirety of 1st to 8th grade. SLA is a place I will always remember in my heart because from the beginning I felt like I don't belong here and it's why I choose to take the path of just getting my work done regardless

of my understanding or why. I just wanted to succeed. It didn't matter to me how I did it but I wanted to make it to college. I wanted to be something amazing and do something I could enjoy. That's why I left an impact on this school. Being autistic I felt like it meant more that I succeed than it would without that and I truly feel like I'm meant to do something great and leave my mark on this school with my capstone and start a journey into my life one that will travel until the end.
