- The Model T was introduced on Oct. 1, 1908. It had a 20-horsepower, four-cylinder engine, reached a top speed of about 45 miles per hour, got about 13 to 21 miles per gallon of gasoline and weighed 1,200 pounds. It was the ninth of Henry Ford's production cars. The Ford Model T car was designed by Childe Harold Willsand and two Hungarian immigrants, Joseph A. Galam and Eugene Farkas.
