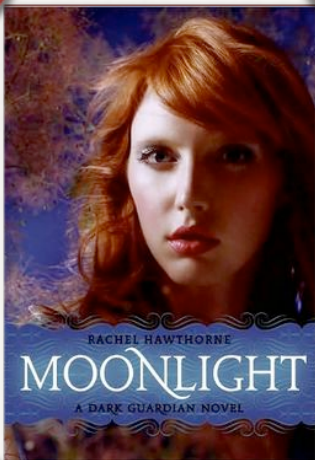


What's happening?!

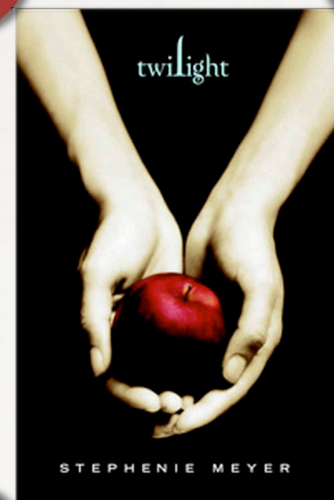
