

What is art? I believe art is a singular creative passion we all hold in our hearts, because it only belongs to us.









Contour drawing of Malala's book and an iPhone 6, lost under a blanket.



Contour drawing of the allergist's office.








Contour drawing of some things in my room.


Weeks 3 - 4 Cond the whole quarter)
