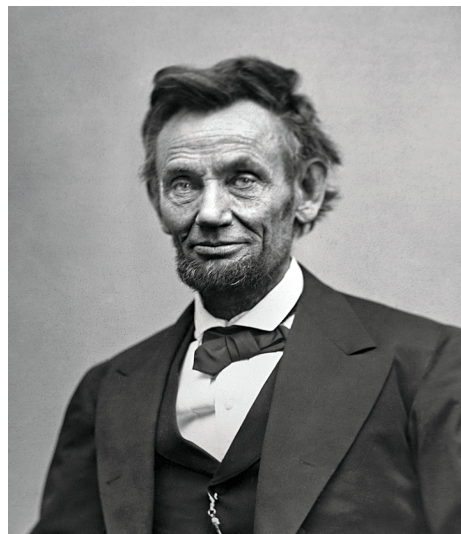
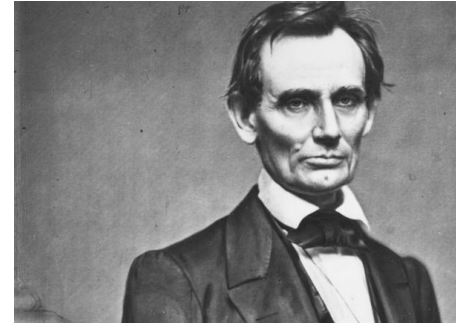
The Legacy
