


Geography:

- In the east are the Gulf of Mexico and the Bay of Campeche, which is formed by Mexico's other peninsula, the Yucatán.




Mexican Culture:

- It large part of Mexican life is hosting large parties at their homes and making the visitors feel comfortable is a huge part of mexican culture.


People:
