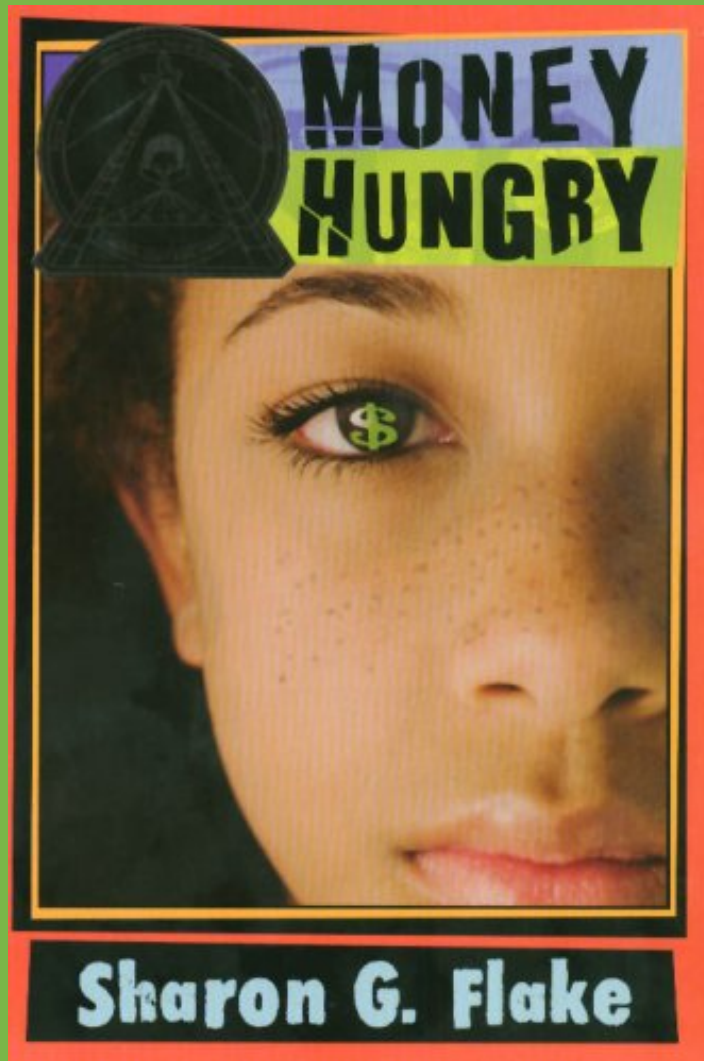


Emulation Handbook

It helps he reader understand the relationships between the Characters.

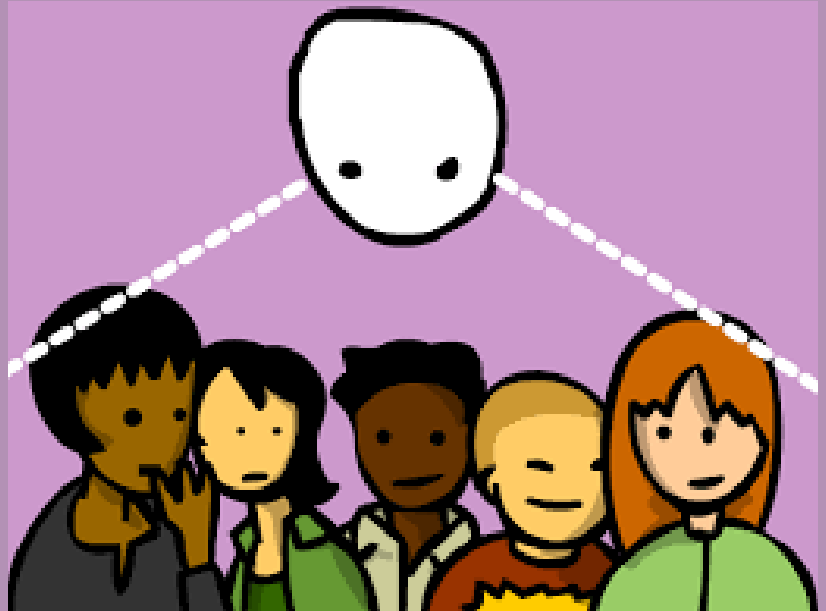
First Person P.O.V
