Set Design

This set design represents Act 5 scene 8 where Macbeth tries to defend his position as king & also represents the site of Macbeth's demise as he is killed by Macduff who was not born of a woman as there was a c-section during his birth. Macbeth is both executed and is then beheaded ending the cruel irony of his reign.

Set Description-

Beam/Black line- Represents the lighting

Walls- The set is a more modern version so the set is more condensed.

3 entries- The entrance near the audience is the site where Malcolm's army enters to take over and the top entrance represents where Macbeth enters before he battles Macduff and the bottom entrance near the steps is connected to the watchtower where Macbeth notices Burname wood moving closer to his kingdom.
