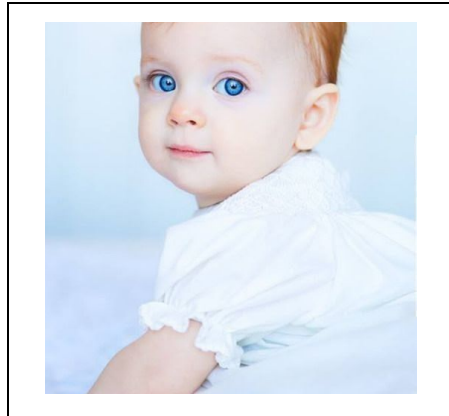
'Future' 'Hot Topic
