I decided to watch supreme live cops, a live cop is where you watch someone try to go for an item, in this case a supreme drop". About 5 videos of live cops later, a youtuber mentioned they have a discord server where they provide all the release info and offer guides on release day. At that moment I downloaded discord as fast as I could, Once I joined the server I felt very overwhelmed, it was a whole new app with a lot going on, after hours of trying to understand how to use discord and what it actually is, I decided to start my own discord server where I would provide supreme release info. On the morning of the first supreme drop I was going for, I was ecstatic. I woke up at 6am to watch Supreme EU drop, a few hours later it was

time for the Supreme US drop, I got to my desk, waited for exactly 11am and tried adding the hoodie I wanted to cart, before I even got to the add to cart button it was sold out. Only after watching more supreme releases did I realize how people are checking out so fast.

I kept here this word "Bot" and I kept hearing different bot brands. At the time I didn't really know what a bot is, but I was very interested, a week later I tried going for the supreme drop again, this time i was using an autofill that would fill out my shipping and billing info for me, Once again I was beaten by so called "Bots". I was feeling really discouraged and didn't even bother going for the next supreme drop. A few weeks later I wanted to give it another shot this time I rented someones bot that I met off discord. Now before I continue I want to express the learning curve of botting, it sounds extremely easy but even to this day there are shoe releases where I get nothing, now back to the story. This time I went into the supreme release extremely confident and guess what, Once again even with my brand new rented bot I got nothing, Instead of feeling down this time I felt very motivated. So motivated that I wanted to make my own bot.

I Decided to write about this because it's something I'm very involved in, reselling and the reselling community/culture. I wanted to give some perspective to what I spend countless hours working and what I'll continue to work on. Trevor Noah's story inspired me a lot, especially his writing style, how he talked in 3rd person but also had some parts in 1st person. The way trevor started out with not much at all, to literally being born a crime, now to being an extremely popular comedian was really motivating since i started reselling with \$0. To this day that motivation is how I succeeded. I now own 3 companies and have built over 4 bots using javascript supporting multiple sites. This month I have made more money than the minimum wage job I'm not even old enough to get.
