**Dark Red** : I think this fits into the dream Hassan had. In pages 59-60, we learn that Hassan has a dream the day of the Kite Fighting in the Winter of 1975. In the dream, there's a lake. The people of Kabul claim there's a monster in the lake but Amir protests and says they're wrong. Of course, Hassan agrees with Amir. Amir jumps in to prove it much to everyone's horror and of course, Hassan follows after him. It turns out there is no monster and the lake is named after Hassan and Amir, they are even able to charge people to visit it and that was the dream ("Something's bad about to happen to me. I don't know what, but I feel it coming"). In pages 60-73, Hassan tells Amir in hopes of deciphering it but they never really figure it out. Amir isn't sure he can win the fight and for a second, I think the monster is Baba but Amir ends up winning the kite fighting and Hassan goes out to run the last kite that dropped. ("And I just let bad thoughts linger for far too long"). This is Amir's big moment, he finally gets Baba's approval but he's waiting on that kite and Hassan is taking some time so he sets out to find him. He is met with Assef raping Hassan and instead of intervening, he runs. Later, he realizes that he was the monster and he was dragging Hassan down. Hassan thought of Amir

as a friend and yet, Amir never really was a friend to Hassan. He treated him like a pet and Hassan's unwavering loyalty to Hassan has, in a way, led to the events in the Winter of 1975.
