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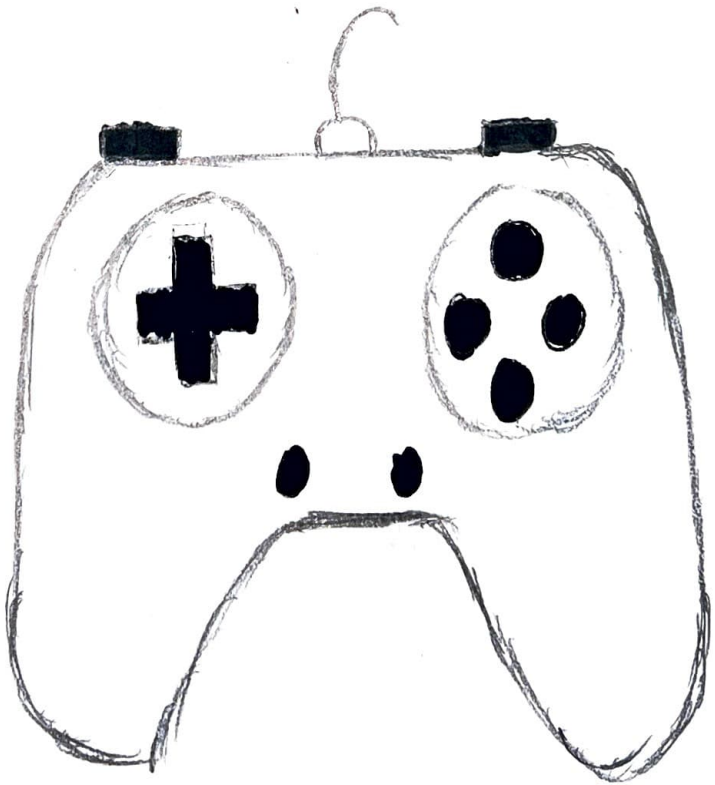

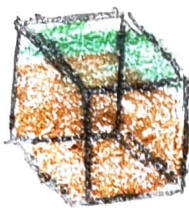

• UNDERTALE

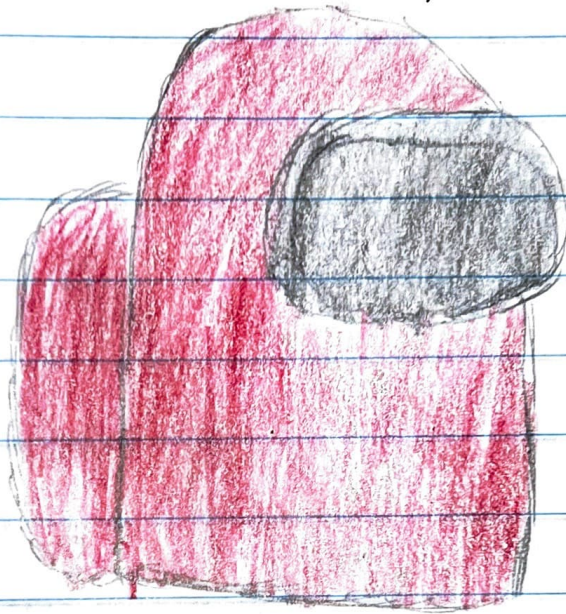
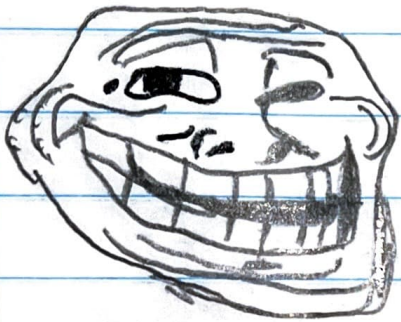


A game where you choose between 3 route. Genocide; Neutral; Pacifist
