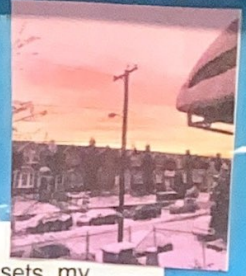

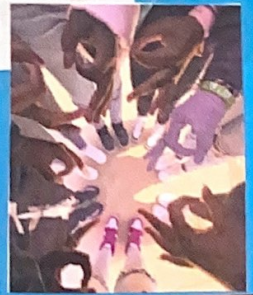
Dear Readers:

Dry Ingredients:

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup corn starch
1 cup flour
2 tsp salt
2 tsp onion powder
2 tsp garlic powder
 $\frac{3}{4}$ tsp cumin
 $\frac{3}{4}$ tsp black pepper
1 tsp chili powder

2 eggs
1 cup milk

Sauce:

1 stick unsalted butter
12 oz buffalo sauce
1 tsp worcestershire sauce
