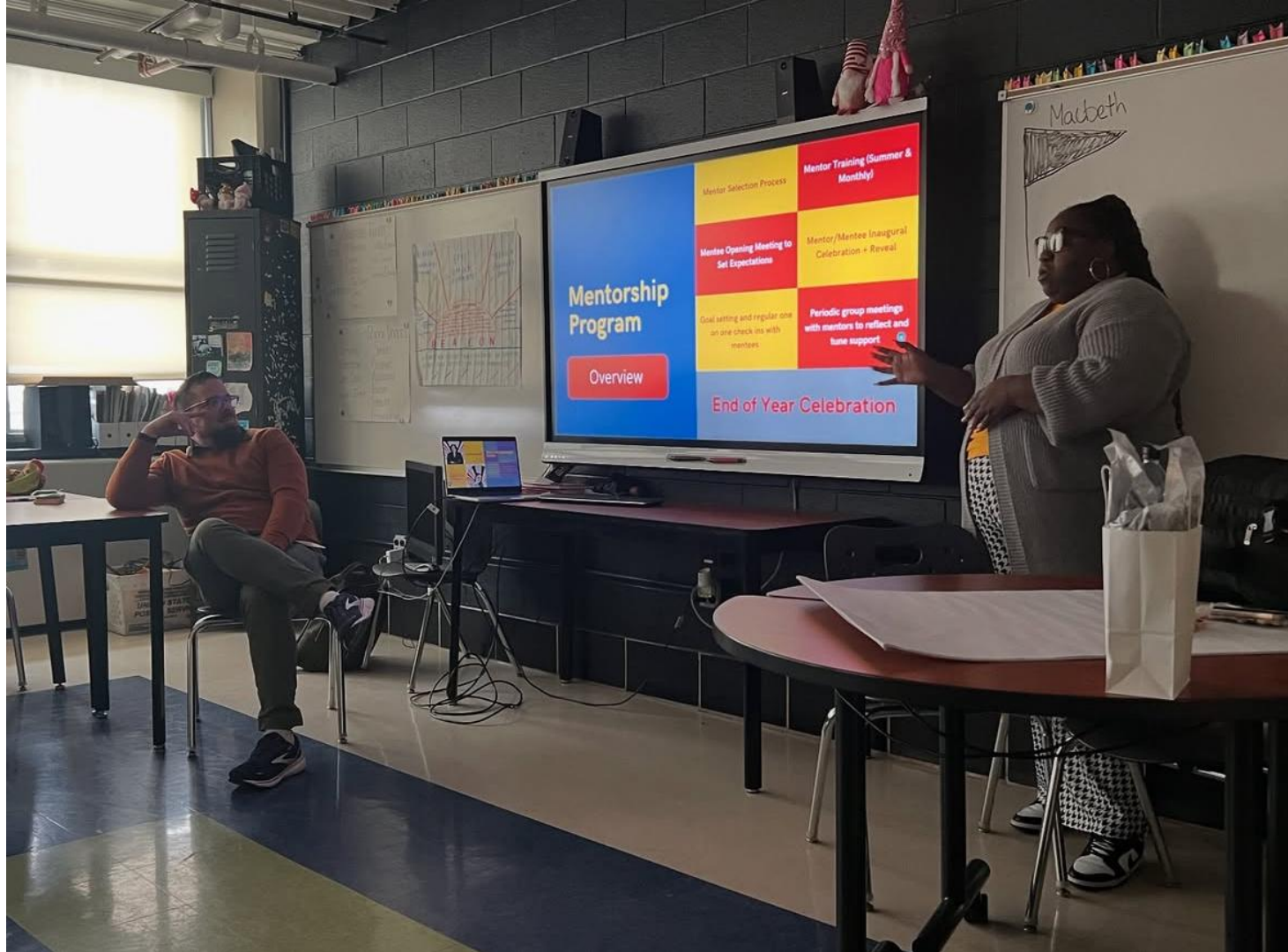
Argument #1

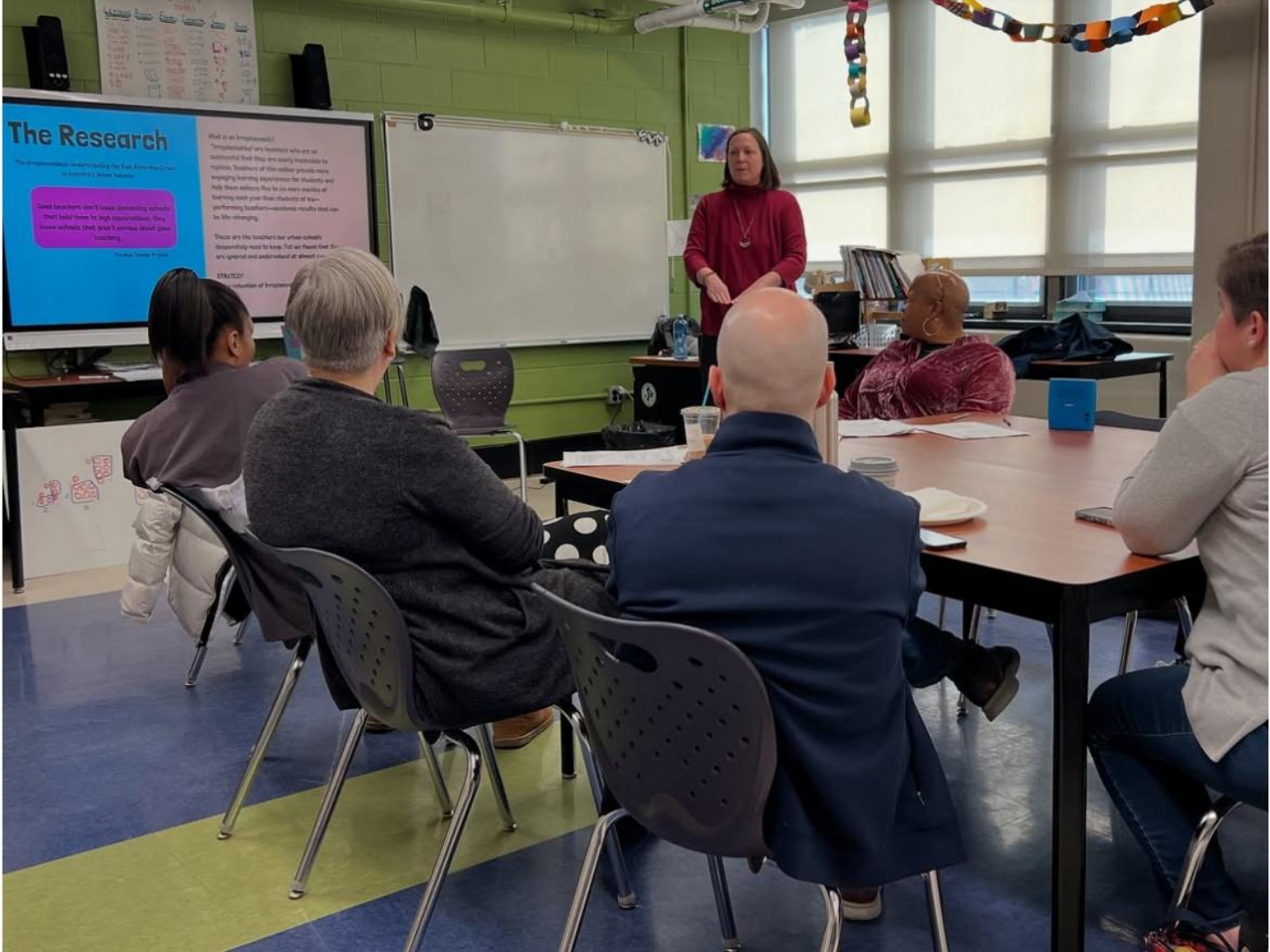

What is an "improvement?"
"Improvement" for teachers who are so successful that they are nearly impossible to replace. Teachers at this school provide more engaging learning experiences for students and hold them to a higher standard than do its many rivals of learning with poor their students of top-performing teacher-education results that can be life-changing.
