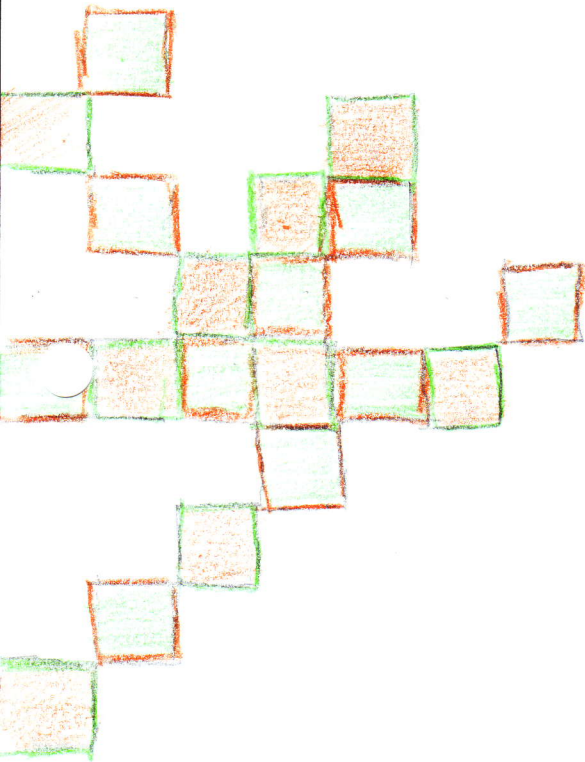
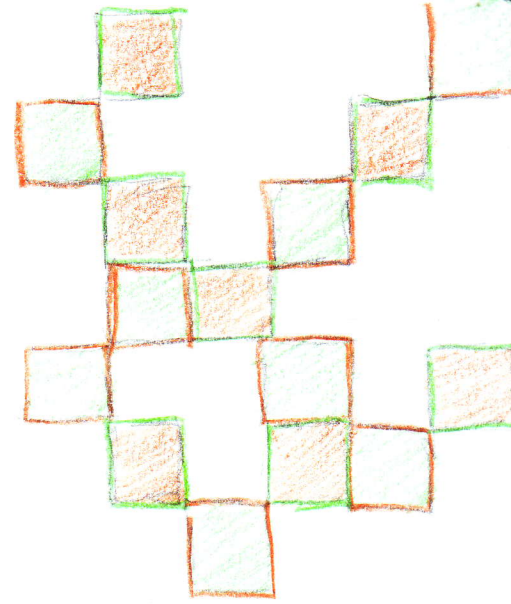
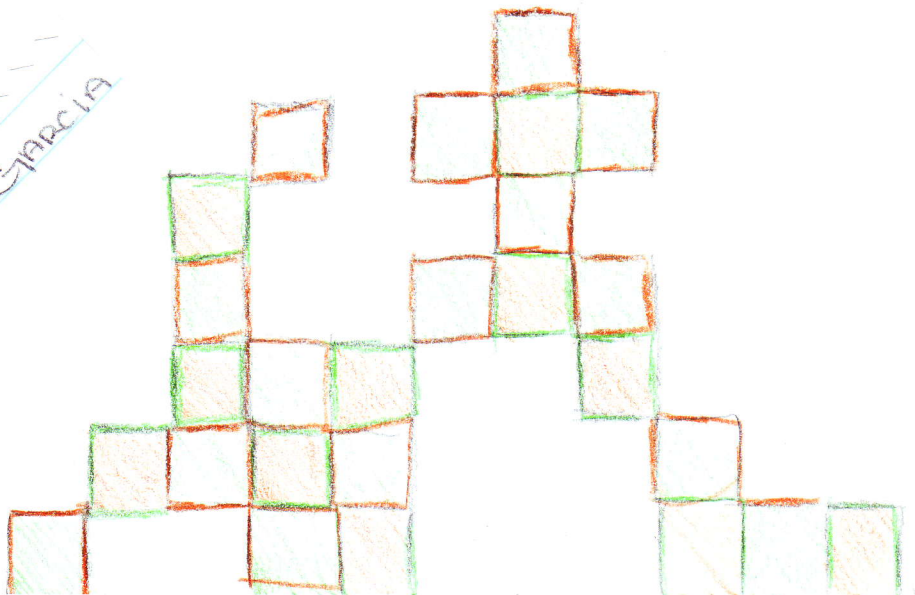

The Sound Behind Music

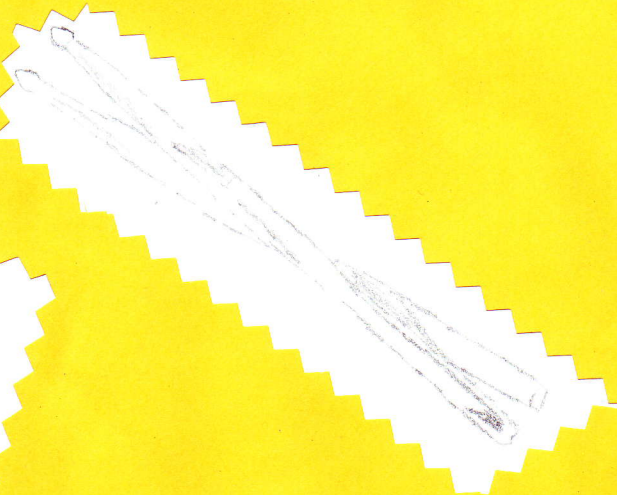
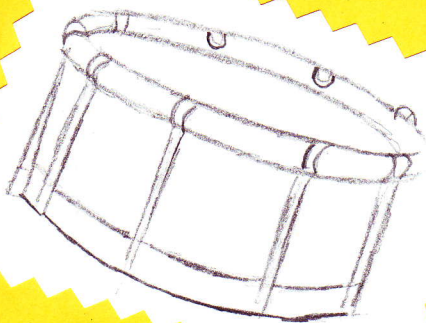
